Guest appraiser Mark Moran is the former senior editor of Antiques and Collectibles Books for Krause Publications in Iola, WI. He has been a contributing editor for Antique Trader magazine and is co-author of more than 25 books including the 800 page annual Warman's Antiques and Collectibles. He is also a guest expert on the PBS series, **Antiques Roadshow**.

Categories of objects for appraisal include:

Fine art: paintings, drawings, prints and statuary.

Furniture: (usually smaller pieces are best)

Ceramics: figural pottery, vases, dishes, kitchenware and stoneware.

Glassware: lighting, marbles and souvenir items.

Vintage Photographs: snapshots, tintypes, ambrotypes and daguerreotypes.

Advertising: posters, lithographed tin, paper and figural objects.

Folk art: carvings, quilts, weathervanes, windmill weights & "outsider" art.

Assorted Toys: dolls (bisque, composition & plastic), windups, and mechanical banks.

Metalware: iron, bronze, brass, pot metal, silver, silver plate.

Clocks: mantel, hanging and figural; also pocket and wristwatches.

Costume Jewelry: brooches, bracelets, and earrings.

Musical Instruments: string, wind and reed instruments.

Books

Sporting memorabilia

Excluded items: all weapons, including swords and knives (folding knives with advertising are accepted); traps (like leg-hold); Nazi memorabilia; coins and paper money; fine jewelry, including precious gems; Beanie Babies



Registration is required to have an antique or collectible appraised.

There is a \$15 per item appraisal fee and a limit of 3 items per registrant.

Fees will be collected the day of the event.
