HOW DO I GET TO AND FROM THE BOOKMOBILE STOPS?

You are asked to arrange your own transportation to meet the Bookmobile at the start time for each date/location that you volunteer. You are also asked to arrange your own transportation to return home from the Bookmobile at the completion of each date/location that you volunteer.

WHAT WILL I DO WHILE VOLUNTERING ON THE BOOKMOBILE?

You will be helping customers as they come to the Bookmobile. Explaining the Summer Reading Adventure program, keeping records of participants, and giving out prizes. Other projects possible: helping set up and presenting events, preparing supplies/ crafts, assisting young children with projects; and/or clean up. Training will be provided to volunteers prior to their shift.

WHAT IF MY VOLUNTEER TIME FALLS DURING A SNACK/MEAL TIME?

Please feel free to bring a snack or meal with you. It is best to have items in a small portable cooler, since there is not a refrigerator on the Bookmobile. If you need to heat up food, a microwave is available for your use. You are responsible for cleaning up after your snack/meal.
