- Event volunteers help at children's programs and events by helping kids with crafts and activities during the events, • dressing up as a costumed character or assisting the person wearing the costume.

We also need substitutes willing to help if people cannot make their regularly scheduled shifts. You can be a sub in addition to your regular shift or only on an as-needed basis.
